Week 5: A Community Vision

During the service, two members of our community were interviewed, sharing reflections on their experiences with Cedar Ridge's vision. The questions asked during the interview were intended to prompt deeper thought about what inspires, challenges, and shapes each person's journey within the church. These questions are valuable for all of us to reflect on and discuss with others. Engaging in these conversations allows us to hear one another's stories, gain new perspectives, and explore how the church's vision shapes us to be a community of hope and transformation.

Below are the five questions used during the interview:

1. Introduce yourself: What's your name, and how long you have been a part of the Cedar Ridge community?

2. What initially drew you to Cedar Ridge, and how has our vision influenced your decision to stay?

3. What part of Cedar Ridge's vision do you find most challenging or stretching for you personally?

4. How have you seen Cedar Ridge's vision evolve over the years?

5. In what ways do you think Cedar Ridge's vision impacts the broader community beyond just our church members?
